Dear colleagues and friends,

On behalf of the Russian Federation Council Committee on Social Policy and myself, I would like to welcome you to Russian Health Care Week 2022.

This year has been a time of great trials and challenges for our country. Russian health care, like all sectors of the economy and social sphere, faced unprecedented sanctions.
